

Study of the Words "Save", "Savior" and "Salvation" (and Derivatives) in the Old Testament ("OT")

- NOTES: 1. This table is based on combining two searches from Logos Bible Software ("Logos"). The term "lemma" means the basic form of a word as found in a Greek or Hebrew lexicon.  
 2. First, the Greek Translation of the OT (Septuagint - Abbr: "LXX") was searched for the Greek lemmas σώζω (save), σωτηρία (salvation), σωτήρ (savior), διασώζω (save) and σωτήριος (bring salvation).  
 3. This search provides corresponding LXX and NASB verses, Greek lemmas, Hebrew roots and English key words.  
 4. Second, the NASB OT was searched for save, salvation and savior. This provides verses, key words and Hebrew roots that might have NOT been found in the first search.  
 5. The combined results are 548 instances of key words in 507 NASB verses. These numbers may vary in other translations. In a few instances there is may be NO corresponding Greek or Hebrew word.  
 6. When the English translation varies from the prevalent meaning of the terms, one must decide if it is an accurate translation based upon the context and the term's typical meaning.  
 7. The English key words are in bold, italic & underlined and followed by the Greek lemma and Hebrew root shown in bold brackets. Only partial verses are shown to reduce the length of the table.  
 8. The questions in the column headings should be answered based upon the context in which the words are found.
